Victory of the 'Living Heritage'

Shriji Arvind Singh Mewar of Udaipur has become the first Indian to win at the 62nd annual Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance event in California, USA. His 1924 Rolls-Royce 20 HP, Barker Tourer (GLK 21) was selected by the panel at the event and it is the first Indian entry to win the Lucius Beebe Trophy at Pebble Beach, USA. Speaking on the eve of the conclusion of the event, Shriji said, "By participating in this event, we want to showcase our legacy and our heritage because today 'Living Heritage' has more currency than luxury whose definition is so dynamic."
